

CNHP Protocols for Showing in 2021

According to NS Public Health, at this time we are limited to 150 people on the grounds at one time. Therefore, spectators are not encouraged.

- 1) There will be a limit of 45 entries accepted at this time. We will continue to monitor the NS Government for changes to gathering limits. Stalls will be available on a first come first serve basis. Each entry of a horse will be permitted to have three persons accompany it, including the rider. The names and contact information of those persons will need to be submitted with the entry form. Each person accompanying the horse will need to fill out a Daily Attestation Form. Plus the rider will need to fill out an event competition waiver.
- 2) Everyone on the show grounds must stay socially distanced, as required by NS Government directives. Barns can form a close social group of up to 10 people without social distancing, which is to be kept consistent, as much as possible. Masks will be mandatory while inside the barns and clubhouse.
- 3) Sanitize your hands frequently, as well as any common areas, such as water taps, before & after use.
- 4) No post entries will be accepted after the closing date.
- 5) All Courses will be posted and circulated ahead of time. They will not be posted on the grounds.
- 6) Competitors will be permitted on the CNHP grounds after 4 PM on May 28, 2021. Everyone will be asked to leave the grounds by 10 PM. Competitors can return to the grounds by 6 AM on May 29, 2021. The gate into the property will be monitored. There will be a few people staying on the grounds overnight to keep an eye on the horses.
- 7) Access to the washroom will be limited to one person per washroom.
- 8) Access to the canteen will be limited, with only prepackaged sandwiches, snacks & drinks being sold.
- 9) We welcome volunteers to help us with the jump course but you must be wearing gloves while handling CNHP equipment. Gloves will be provided.
